PayCheck Plus calculator

Senator ABETZ: ... So, have any changes been made in recent times to the wage calculator? Mr Wilson: There have. Between July 2012 and 31 December 2012 I am informed that there were 223 changes, corrections or amendments—however you wish to characterise it. Senator ABETZ: But not necessitated by changes to awards? It stands to reason that when wage increases come through or awards are changed that the calculator will need to be changed. What I want to concentrate on is where it was found to be—and I am trying to think of a neutral term—not as accurate as it otherwise might be. They are the changes that I am looking at. Mr Wilson: They are in that second category, and I have a table, which we can provide on notice, which gives you the categorisation of them.
