## **Inclusion Support subsidy**

Senator BILYK: How many of these services used this subsidy to bring on additional staff members to support the child? Mr De Silva: The inclusion support subsidy is used by IA services to engage, and that is what it is used for. I do not have the exact number of educators, because it is done by hours. Senator BILYK: Could you take that on notice? Are you able to access that data? Mr De Silva: I will double-check if we can, but I will take it on notice. Senator BILYK: Thank you.
