ACARA has provided the following response.

Professor Barry McGaw AO, Chair, Australian Curriculum, Assessment and Reporting Authority received a letter dated 22 January 2014 from Professor Wiltshire and Dr Donnelly. The letter requested information on the approach used by ACARA in developing the Australian Curriculum. Professor McGaw responded on 4 February 2014.
