## Question

### **SWA - Communication staff**

For all departments and agencies, please provide – in relation to all public relations, communications and media staff – the following: a) How many ongoing staff, the classification, the type of work they undertake and their location. b) How many non-ongoing staff, their classification, type of work they undertake and their location c) How many contractors, their classification, type of work they undertake and their location d) How many are graphic designers? e) How many are media managers? f) How many organise events?

### **Answer**

- a) Safe Work Australia has seven full-time equivalent (FTE) ongoing staff members, located in Canberra, undertaking the following communications activities:
  - development and implementation of communication strategies and provision of strategic communications advice
  - media management and liaison including proactive media activities
  - strategic communication liaison with the Commonwealth, state and territory work health and safety authorities, business, industry and inion groups
  - online services (internet and intranet) design, development and maintenance
  - publication design and print management
  - general enquiries management and monitoring
  - speakers and sponsorship request evaluation and recommendation, and
  - management of national events and initiatives.
