Question

Youth Unemployment by Region and Electorate

1. What is the rate of youth unemployment rate in Australia? 2. How is this figure measured and established? Is it measured by the use of data collected by the ABS?
3. How is "youth" defined in the data? 4. Please provide a table which shows the rate of youth unemployment for the last four quarters for which data is available by state and territory. 5. Please provide a table which shows the rate of youth unemployment for the last four quarters of 2013 by every local government area in Australia.
6. Please provide a table which shows the rate of youth unemployment for the last four quarters by every federal electorate in Australia.

Answer

1. The current youth (persons aged 15-24 years) unemployment rate in Australia is 12.9 per cent, as at February 2014.
2. Australia's official labour market statistics (including the youth unemployment rate), are compiled by the Australia Bureau of Statistics (ABS) from information collected as part of its monthly *Labour Force Survey*. The youth unemployment rate measures the number of unemployed youth expressed as a proportion of the youth labour force (i.e. level of youth unemployment and level of youth employment).
3. Youth are defined by the ABS as persons aged 15-24.
4. State/Territory youth unemployment rates, four quarters to February 2014.
