Question:

What I was after was a breakdown of the amount next to each of those national projects. I was interested to know, regarding the amount next to the *Dare to Lead* program, how much of the \$11.5 million has been allocated against the program?

Answer:

Funding for the Indigenous education National Projects

The 2001 figure of \$11.5 million quoted for NIELNS National Projects in the *National Report to Parliament on Indigenous Education and Training* does not take into account funds allocated in 2000 for those projects which commenced in 2000. The amount of \$13.1 million allocated for these National Projects extends over the period 2000-2004 and covers the full life of each of the projects. These figures are identified in the attached table:
