#### **Ouestion:**

Senator Carr asked at *Hansard* page 14:

How many AWAs has the Australian Mines and Metals Association submitted to the OEA?

#### Answer:

Currently, the OEA's workflow system does not collect information about the number of AWAs lodged by Industry Partners, on behalf of employers, in a form which allows statistical reporting.

From July 2003, the OEA will implement an automated system to record the number of AWAs lodged by Industry Partners – including the Australian Mines and Metals Association - on behalf of employers.
