#### **Ouestion:**

Senator Wong asked at *Hansard* page 16:

(a) Please provide details of dates of discussions between the Australian Mines and Metals Association and anyone in the OEA regarding an AWA pro-forma for submission?

(b) Please provide copies of any documents that you have received in that context?

#### **Answer:**

- (a) In 1999-2000, an officer of the OEA had informal discussions with officers of AMMA concerning the possibility of an AWA framework for the mining industry. The OEA officer has since resigned and it is not possible to provide information about the specific dates of these informal discussions.
- (b) To the best of the OEA's knowledge, no AWA framework or pro-forma resulted from those informal discussions.
