Senator George Campbell asked at *Hansard* page 178:

Can you provide the employment outcomes that have been achieved for all employed Indigenous persons within COAG locations including:

- (a) the percentage that are employed full time;
- (b) the percentage that are employed part time;
- (c) the percentage that are employed casually; and
- (d) a total.

**Answer:**

The employment outcomes that have been achieved through funding under the Indigenous Employment Programme in Shepparton and Cape York are set out in the table below:
