Answer:

The Department models its outcomes projections on a National level. The following figures are our modelled expectations for the life of *Employment Services Contract 2003-2006*.

Number of job seekers who become eligible for Intensive Support*	1,680,000
Primary Interim Outcomes:	570,000
Secondary Interim Outcomes	60,000
Primary Final Outcomes:	115,000
Secondary Final Outcomes:	30,000

*Includes number of job seekers eligible for Intensive Support job search training and highly disadvantaged job seekers eligible for Intensive Support customised assistance. There is no commencement fee as such under the new contract arrangements.
