Could a breakdown please be provided of costs associated with contract management activities with Job Network members, as well as contract management activities for other services such as Work for the Dole, harvest labour services and the New Enterprise Incentive Scheme?

**Answer:**

The PBS reports aggregate prices for delivery of employment services (output 1.2.2). The Department does not disaggregate costs attributable to contract management activities for each employment service. The Department deploys its resources in a flexible way across these services, adjusting inputs through the year as required including at the State Office level.
