Question:

Who were the employers who put a significant proportion of their workforce into Certificate III Information Technology (Software Applications)?

Answer:

Employers with New Apprentices Undertaking Certificate III IT (Software Applications)

According to data held within the Department's Training and Youth Internet Management System (TYIMS), there were 94 employers who employed twenty or more New Apprentices that were registered against the Certificate III Information Technology (Software Applications) qualifications in Victoria.

The information provided has been compiled using data provided to the Department by the Victorian Office of Training and Tertiary Education (OTTE) in August 2003. It is not possible to determine whether or not this represents a significant proportion of the employer's workforce as the Department does not hold any reliable information on an employer's total workforce.
