The latest Australian Bureau of Statistics (ABS) Survey of Education and Work for May 2003 shows that there were 14,000 people aged between 15 and 24 who attended Year 10 in 2002 and who were not working or studying in May 2003. This group comprised 7,600 unemployed people and 6,400 people not in the labour force.
