Question:

- a) What is the DEST estimate of the number of potential students who could miss out on TAFE places this year?
- b) Does DEST agree with the TAFE Directors Australia claim that up to 50,000 potential students could miss out on TAFE places this year?

Answer:

Unmet demand for TAFE places

- a) DEST uses NCVER estimates for unmet demand for VET, which includes a TAFE measure. These figures are produced from an ABS survey, and give figures for the preceding year. For 2003, this was 45,900 for TAFE (the latest available data).
- b) NCVER will provide its estimate for 2004 in 2005, when ABS survey data is available.
