## Question:

## Answer:

Exempting scholarships

It is not possible for the Department to determine the cost to the Government of exempting part-time scholarship recipients from income tax. The Department does not hold data on all the different scholarships that are offered to students by Government and non-Government education providers. The Australian Taxation Office is responsible for policy on the income tax treatment of scholarships.
