How much money was initially proposed for the medical school at James Cook University?

Answer:

Medical School at James Cook University

James Cook University medical school was allocated \$10 million (in 1999 dollars) in capital funding from the Health Portfolio. This was conditional on the Queensland Government matching these funds.

James Cook University was funded for 60 intake medical places per year at \$20,000 per place (including HECS).
