What other (industrial) issues were there (which led to an industrial dispute in April)? ... What other issues are causing difficulty?

Answer:

ANSTO - Industrial Issues

ANSTO has provided the following response:

On Monday 5 April 2004 following an application by ANSTO, the AIRC issued S127 orders requiring the cessation of industrial bans and a return to work in respect of AMWU members employed as HIFAR operators. The bans were imposed on or around 11 pm on Friday 2 April 2004.

On Tuesday 6 April 2004, the AMWU lodged a dispute in the AIRC. The dispute notification identified the following issue as matters in dispute.

- 1. Failure to undertake meaningful consultation
- 2. Use of individual contracts
- 3. Introduction of a 5 shift roster for the RRR
- 4. Breach of contract of employment
- 5. Coercion of employees
- 6. Training and development of existing employees

This matter is listed for hearing in August.
