- b) Can you tell me how long the consultancy lasted?
- c) Can I have a copy of that [report] please?

Answer:

CSIRO has provided the following response.

Phoenix Group Pacific Pty Ltd

- a) Dr Jack Steele, Chief of Staff, Corporate Business Development and Commercialisation.
- b) Approximately a 6 month period.
- c) Yes, copies of the report and appendix are attached. In summary, the outcomes of the consultancy included:
 - the assembly of a centralised database of CSIRO's involvement with CRCs since the commencement of the CRC Programme;
 - a review of CSIRO's engagement with the CRC Programme;
 - recommendations as to future CSIRO engagement with the CRC Programme; and
 - the development of a basis for CSIRO to establish a "CRC Engagement Office".
 This has subsequently been formed and is the front-line process for managing CSIRO's involvement with CRCs, in particular with the current Round 9 CRCs, which has included the preparation of standard form agreements that would be used in all (or almost all) cases of Round 9 CRCs.
