Mr Dean – taxation requirements

As a matter of clarification, some of the payments to Groman Consulting SA (PTY) LTD were made in US\$. However, the total payments to Groman Consulting amount to AUS\$740,000, following relevant exchange rate conversions.

The income of Groman Consulting SA (PTY) LTD is subject to South African income taxes. Mr Ian Dean, as principal of Groman Consulting, is operating his domestic and international consulting business out of his South African Company.
