**Question:**

Senator Campbell asked at *Hansard* page 37:

Where job seekers have had the Job Seeker Account drawn on by the provider, what percentage of those job seekers have been successful in finding employment, particularly 13 weeks or more?

**Answer:**

Of the job seekers who have had Job Seeker Account funds expended on them, 68% have been placed in employment. Of those job seekers whose placement occurred more than 13 weeks ago, 42% have achieved an interim outcome.
