Question:

You say that the CGS amount will be increased, subject to conditions applied to institutions, by 7.5% by 2007, "to assist the sustainability and quality of the sector".

- (a) What does that phrase imply?
- (b) Doesn't it imply that the sector is currently, or will soon become, unsustainable and of less-than-ideal quality?
- (c) If not, why did the Government decide to make this considerable amount of money available?

Answer:

Clarify the implications of the phrase "to assist the sustainability and quality of the sector"
