#### Question:

Does the department have any projections for the take up of FEE- HELP loans over the forward estimates period?

#### Answer:

Take-up of FEE-HELP loans

Estimates of the take up of FEE-HELP loans are based on equivalent full time student study load, rather than the number of students. The Department's estimates of the take up of FEE-HELP loans over the forward estimates period is provided in the following table. The estimates will be revised in the light of experience.
