Question:

I have had some Aboriginal communities asked me if they can have two flagpoles because they would like to fly both flags.

Answer:

Flagpoles

The Flagpole Funding Initiative provides for one flagpole per school where there is currently no functioning flagpole. If a school already has a functioning flagpole it is ineligible for a second flagpole under this initiative.

If a school does not have a functioning flagpole, it is recommended that a yardarm style flagpole, which enables three flags to be flown, be purchased.
