Senator Wong asked at *Hansard* page 31:

In regard to the JSCI frequency distribution graph, under the 23 highly disadvantaged threshold, how many people fall on this graph if the line is moved from 23 to 25?

Answer:

There was an inflow in calendar year 2004 of around 14,900 job seekers (who had a JSCI score and a Vocational Profile completed and weren't re-registrants) with 23 or 24 JSCI points.
