Dr Peacock's role in CSIRO

As chair of the Science Team, Dr Peacock's role in CSIRO is to provide scientific advice, especially on emerging science, the building and fostering of science leaders, stimulating our PhD and post graduate programs and working on ways to enhance CSIRO's contribution in science education and outreach.

Dr Peacock's current CSIRO term is until the end of 2007.
