- b. Please provide any information about how the children performed in the Year 5 tests, which they should have done in 2005?

Answer:

Pilot Tutorial Voucher Initiative – student outcomes

The Department does not have access to benchmark results for individual students. Overall results from the pilot indicate that the majority of students who received tuition had improved their reading scores, and a significant proportion of these students had improved considerably with an average gain of around 12 months in terms of reading age.
