Eligibility for ABSTUDY to live away from home to undertake secondary schooling

The above question relates to the establishment of a non-government secondary college on Melville Island.

No. Families can choose to send their children to this school, or any other school in the Northern Territory, and still receive ABSTUDY. The level of ABSTUDY assistance available is subject to personal circumstances as assessed against eligibility outlined in the ABSTUDY Policy Manual.
