#### **Answer:**

KPMG were commissioned to conduct an evaluation of the Supported Wage System (SWS) in 2002. One of the Terms of Reference was to "determine the efficiency of the SWS in facilitating client outcomes in relation to the actual costs of assessment, on the job support and programme administration; and in the consistency of programme operation and administration". The evaluation report did not make any recommendations regarding the rate of assessment.
