**Question:**

Senator Wong asked at *Hansard* page 69:

In relation to uncapped (DEN) places, what proportion of this population will fall into the 0-15, 15-29 and 30-and-over categories for hours of work capacity?

**Answer:**

It is anticipated that approximately 21,000 people will commence into Disability Employment Network uncapped places over the three year period. People with an assessed capacity of 30 hours or more do not access the uncapped places, nor do people with an assessed capacity of less than 15 hours after two years of assistance.
