### **Question:**

Senator Crossin asked at *Hansard* page 60: What is the increase in the STEP contract in the Tiwi Islands?

#### **Answer:**

There are three current STEP contracts in place on Tiwi Islands. Two of these were negotiated in 2004 and have a combined value of \$1.66 million. A third, unrelated, contract was negotiated in 2006 with a value of \$0.99 million. Therefore, the total amount of STEP funds committed as at 30 June 2005 was \$1.66 million and as at 30 June 2006 was \$2.65 million.
