#### **Question:**

Senator Wong asked in writing:

On the Centrelink registry for Financial Case Management, the document initially stated that a client could have expenses paid that were a result of 'other unavoidable or reasonable costs'. When was this clause removed, and why?

#### Answer:

It was not removed. 'Other unavoidable or reasonable costs' is still part of current policy when deciding what an essential expense is.

While these words are not specifically mentioned on the Centrelink website, they are contained in the guidelines for NGO contracts and other Financial Case Management policy documents.
