Work Choices seminars: Of the 17 organisations delivering these seminars can the department provide a breakdown of the funding that has been provided to date? What proportion of the money has been spent on providing associated materials such as brochures, CDs and DVDs etc.

## **Answer:**

For the 17 organisations contracted to provide WorkChoices seminars the total of contracted fees payable are \$7.995M (ex. GST). The fee breakdown by contracted provider is presented in the table below.
