Senator Wong asked in writing:

Is DEWR aware of a public comment made by a construction company executive on 23 March 2006 (as reported in the Sydney Morning Herald) that the new federal laws 'attack the industry's right to work co-operatively with our own workforce.... the construction unions have been quite responsible since the Gyles Royal Commission'.

## **Answer:**

Yes, DEWR is aware of unattributed comments allegedly made by an executive about the behaviour of construction industry unions since the 1990 New South Wales Gyles Royal Commission. The unattributed comments are sharply at odds with the findings of the 2003 Royal Commission into the Building and Construction Industry which found widespread lawlessness in the industry.
