Question:

Senator Marshall asked at *Hansard* (29 May 2006) page 84:

In relation to the information provided by employers that 20 employees were covered by employer greenfields agreements at the time of lodgement, being information the OEA believes was provided in error at lodgement, please advise what action the OEA has taken to follow up on that.

Answer:

The information provided pertained to 20 employees covered by a variation to an employer greenfields agreement, lodged in the same month. This information must be provided by an employer when lodging a variation agreement. The OEA did not need to take any action in that regard.
