Senator Marshall asked at *Hansard* (29 May 2006) pages 93 & 96:

Please provide details of all the results of the coding for the sample of 250 AWAs for the month of April 2006.

Answer:

The statistical spreadsheets, containing details of coding results for each of the 250 AWAs sampled, also contain the unique identifiers assigned to the agreements on lodgement with the Office of the Employment Advocate. Release of these agreement identifiers could lead to the parties to AWAs being identified, which is prohibited under section 165 of the *Workplace Relations Act 1996*.
