Senator Marshall asked at *Hansard* (29 May 2006) page 97:

Please provide a breakdown of the number of casual, part-time and full-time employees covered by the sample AWAs.

Answer:

The sample of 250 Australian workplace agreements covered 64 casual employees, 44 part-time employees and 141 full-time employees. One record was found to be inaccessible and therefore, whilst part of the sample, was not coded.
