#### **Question:**

Senator Wong asked at Hansard (29 May 2006) page 99:

Of the 41% in the sample that do not retain the protected gazetted public holidays, how many have, and how many do not have, an alternate day to replace the gazetted public holidays?

#### **Answer:**

The 41% in the sample of 250 agreements either excluded or modified the protected award condition 'Declared Public Holidays': 36 per cent <u>excluded</u> it and 4 per cent <u>modified</u> it. Due to rounding, this adds to only 40 per cent.

The OEA did not establish whether the 36 per cent of AWAs that excluded the PAC 'Declared Public Holidays' did, or did not have, an alternative day to replace the gazetted public holidays.
