Senator Marshall asked at *Hansard* (29 May 2006) page 104:

Please provide details of the analysis of a sample of collective agreements by the Department of Employment and Workplace Relations.

## **Answer:**

A total of 95 collective agreements lodged under WorkChoices were analysed.

Of the 95 collective agreements, 15 were employer greenfields agreements, 5 were union greenfields agreements, 48 were employee collective agreements and 27 were union collective agreements. Of the 95 agreements, 28 were replacement agreements for expired pre-WorkChoices agreements.
