Senator Marshall asked at Hansard (30 May 2006) page 12:

How many employers' requests for advice whether an agreement contains prohibited content, are outstanding for more than 30 days?

### Answer:

As at 30 May 2006, 20 applications were outstanding for more than 30 days, from a total of 284 applications being processed by the Office of the Employment Advocate. This represents 7.04 per cent of applications being processed.
