**Question:**

Senator Campbell and Senator Marshall asked at *Hansard* (30 May 2006) page 16:

Please provide a reconciliation of the number of AWAs by postcode with federal electorates. Please provide information about the software product that assigns postcodes to electorates.

**Answer:**

AWA postcode data (i.e. the residential postcode of employee parties to AWAs) is assigned to federal electoral divisions using an Excel spreadsheet supplied to the Department of Employment and Workplace Relations (DEWR) by the Australian Electoral Commission (AEC).

This Excel spreadsheet requires that the OEA populate a worksheet with AWA postcode data. This worksheet is then linked to a worksheet containing the relevant electoral information. Using particular functionality available in Excel, the software assigns AWA postcodes to the 151 federal electorates.

The OEA has streamlined this process by linking the electoral information in Excel to an Access database that is linked to the OEA's workflow system (i.e. the AWA management system).

The attached is the electoral data output for the three years to 31 March 2006. The OEA estimates 'live' AWAs using this three year methodology.

**Important note:** AWA data sorted by electorate is subject to some error. This is due to the way employee postcode data is assigned to an electorate - i.e. where a postcode straddles two or more electorates the software assigns the record to one electorate only. Further, not all employee postcodes notified to the OEA are valid postcodes - these are removed from the count. Removal of invalid postcodes results in the total electoral count being 1-2 per cent less than the actual AWA approval number.
