Senator Marshall asked in writing:

Can the OEA provide details on AWA compliance with the minimum sick leave provisions provided by the WorkChoices legislation?

## **Answer:**

No. The legal requirement is that the Australian Fair Pay and Conditions Standard (AFPCS) is met in practice. The OEA cannot determine compliance with the AFPCS from the content of an agreement alone.
