Senator Siewert asked in writing:

Both the Minister and the Commissioner have indicated that an important purpose of the BCII Act is to remove obstacles to productivity in the building and construction industry. What procedures are in place to monitor productivity in the building and construction industry? Is baseline data available? Are activities underway to quantify and report on productivity gains?

**Answer:**

The ABCC has not undertaken a formal study to quantify and report on productivity gains.
