Senator Carr asked on 31 May 2007, EWRE Hansard page 47.

**Question:**

**Senator CARR**—For \$42 billion worth of expenditure?

**Ms Paul**—We are talking about non-government funding here. That \$42 billion refers to the SPP.

**Senator CARR**—I know, but two-thirds of that will go to the non-government sector. All right, so I am wrong, but it is only two-thirds?

**Mr Burmester**—I am not sure about that proportion.

**Senator CARR**—Is that right?

**Mr Burmester**—I will have to check that.

**Answer:**

*Quadrennium Funding*

Currently estimated total public expenditure on the government schools sector is 75%, whilst total public expenditure on the Non-government schools sector is 25%.

It is not possible to accurately estimate proportions for future public expenditure.
