Question:

Senator CARR—With regard to the new national code, is it the case that employers of international students who wish to provide them with short-term training modules will need to be registered under CRICOS?

Dr Jarvie—I will have to take that on notice.

Answer:

CRICOS

There has been no change to the *Education Services for Overseas Students Act 2000* in regard to the registration of courses. It requires all courses of education and training for overseas students studying in Australia on a student visa to be registered on CRICOS.
