## Question:

## Answer:

Electrotechnology and Data Communications – Licensing, the Ageing Workforce and Industry Dissemination: Analysis of issues and development of solutions'

- 1. This project was funded through the National Skills Shortages Strategy to assist in addressing skills needs in the electrotechnology industry.
- 2. The Australian Chamber of Commerce and Industry received \$340,500 (GST exclusive) for the project. The National Electrical and Communications Association was subcontracted for this project.
  - Proposals for funding are submitted to the department from a range of stakeholder organisations, including industry groups, on an ongoing basis.
- 3. A proposal for this project was submitted to the department from the Australian Chamber of Commerce and Industry and approved for funding by the Minister.
- 4. The department evaluated the project in terms of it meeting its contractual requirements and producing the nominated project deliverables. A final project report demonstrating the performance of the project against this criteria was received and approved by the department in February 2006.
