Please note:

- 1. Data on grants of payments are collected on a weekly basis. Therefore, it is not possible to report monthly counts of the number of grants. In the table above, the numbers of grants over four-weekly periods since 1 July 2006 have been reported.
- 2. The total number of grants of Newstart Allowance or Youth Allowance (other) with partial capacity to work (15-29 hours per week) up to 30 March 2007 reported in the table above is higher than that reported in *Hansard* page 104 (7,915). This is due to the later extraction date and the lag effect which occurs as a result of the time required to complete the Job Capacity Assessment (JCA) process. This lag effect is estimated to be up to three months. This data is likely now to reflect actual grants in the period to 30 March 2007.
- 3. The total number of grants of Newstart Allowance or Youth Allowance (other) for principal carers up to 30 March 2007 reported in the table above is higher than that reported in *Hansard* page 104 (19,200). The figure reported in Hansard is the total number of grants of Newstart Allowance or Youth Allowance (other) for principal carers up to 23 March 2007.
