Senator Wong asked at Hansard page 116:

<u>Welfare to Work transitions</u>: Can the department provide an update of W1071-07 which related to Parenting Payment recipients estimated to face activity requirements from 1 July 2007 (broken down by PPS and PPP status and by State)

#### Answer:

Based on information as at the end of March 2007, it is expected that around 223,000 parenting payment recipients are estimated to face participation requirements on 1 July 2007. The numbers broken down by State and Territory and by payment type are shown below:
