**Question**

Can you provide a breakdown of existing staffing levels at the Australian Industrial Registry?

**Answer**

The Australian Industrial Registry has provided the following response.

The Registry has 177 staff excluding contractors and staff seconded from other agencies. The breakdowns provided are consistent with staffing data published in the Registry's Annual Reports, first by functional area and second by location and gender by APS classification.
