Number of Students Eligible for the An Even Start Program – by State/Territory

Of the 150,000 students eligible for the *An Even Start Program* (previously the Reading Assistance Vouchers program) nationally, what are the disaggregated figures by states and territories?

Answer

Eligible students will register for An Even Start over the course of 2008. As at 25 July 2008, 79,733 of the eligible students had registered. The breakdown by state and territory is shown below.
