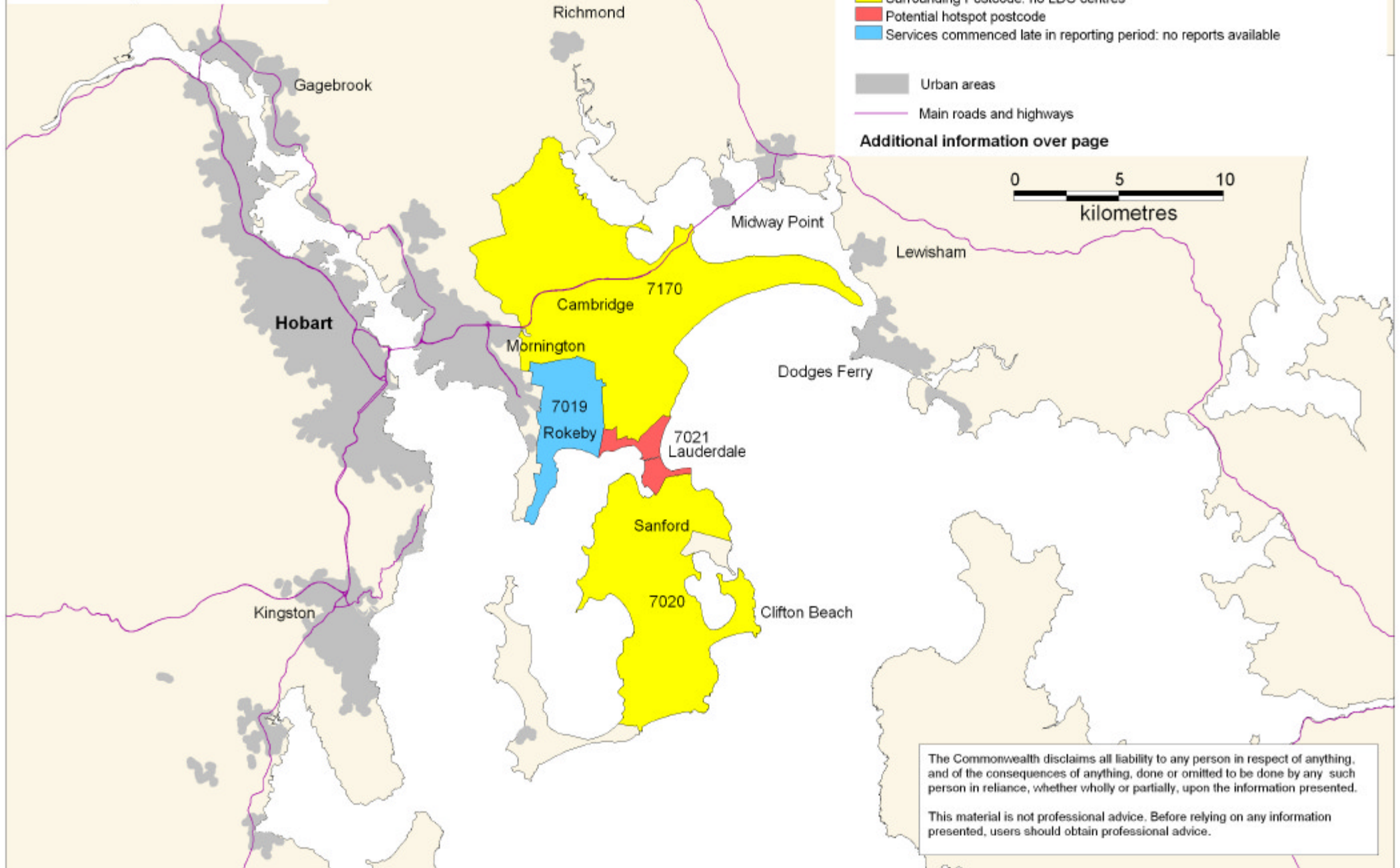




# Tasmania - Hobart: July - December 2006

- A new service started operation in one of the adjoining postcodes during the July-December 2006 period.
- The majority of adjoining postcodes did not have long day care centres.

Family day care as an alternative (July-December 2006)

- There were family day care vacancies in the potential hotspot postcode and in at least 1 adjoining postcode.

Planning applications (July-December 2006)

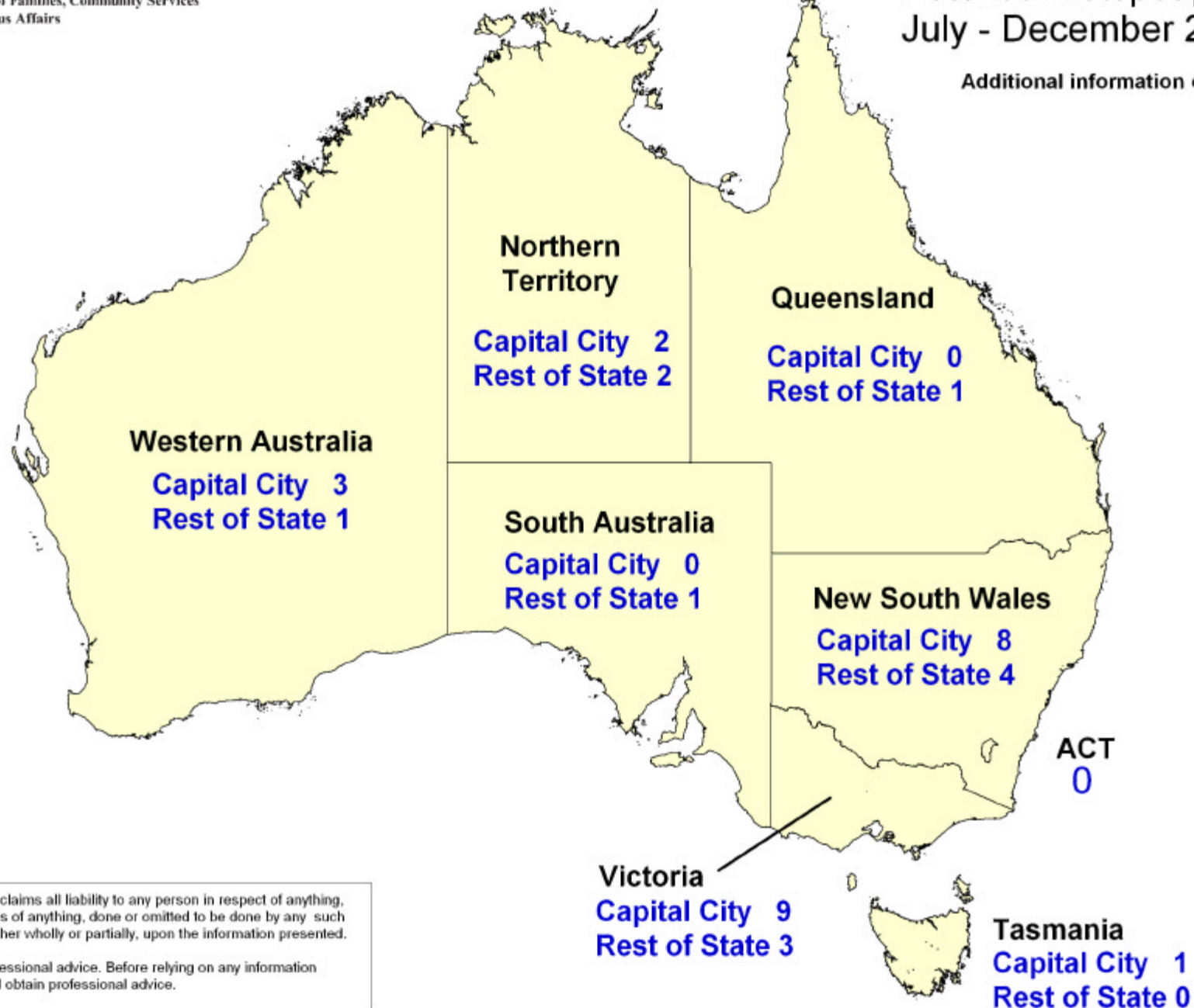
- Planning applications for new long day care centres have been submitted to local councils in the adjoining postcodes.
